

Drop-off and Pick-up

Students should arrive between 8:15-8:30am and must be picked up promptly at 12:15pm. Guardians must park and walk their students into the building to sign them in. Guardians must also park and enter to sign students out. Late Pick-ups may result in removal from the program without refund.

Medical needs/allergies

Staff is not allowed to administer medication. Staff must be informed in writing of any special circumstances which may affect the student's ability to participate fully and within the guidelines of acceptable behavior, including any serious behavioral problems or special circumstances regarding physical, psychological, or medical conditions.

Dress Code

Dress appropriately for physical activity. NO open-toed, "cros", or open-backed shoes are permitted. Shirts must have minimum 1" wide shoulder straps. Clothing that displays drugs, alcohol, tobacco, offensive language, excessive bagginess, or is excessively revealing will not be permitted.

Discipline Policy

In the event a child's behavior cannot be corrected by Staff with a verbal warning or other form of behavior modification, guardian will be contacted. If repeat parent contact is required, student can be suspended or dismissed without refund. Immediate dismissal can occur at any time and without refund, given severe circumstances.

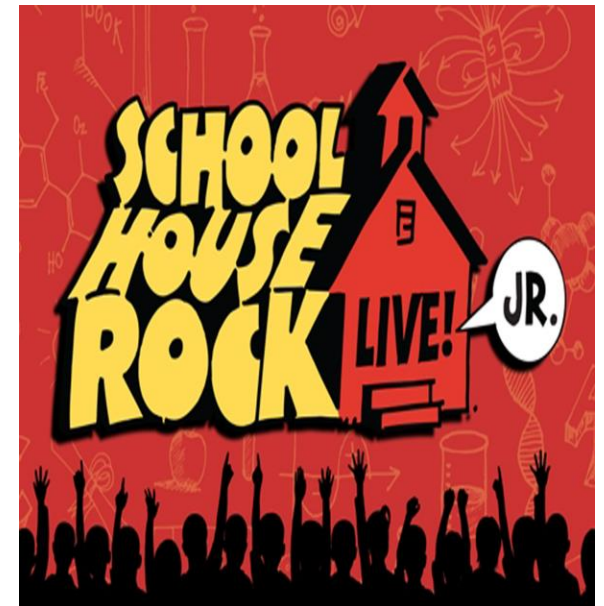
